 - The Skating Club of Novi is committed to skater safety. We will be following the guidelines and policies set forth by the Novi Ice Arena and US Figure Skating.

HOW TO REGISTER

- It is important to read this ENTIRE packet carefully. Please let us know if you have any questions!
- Follow the QR code to register. The <u>non-refundable</u> deposit will be paid through Square. You will find a link at the end of the registration page. All other payments will be billed through Stripe.
- PLEASE NOTE:
 - To complete your registration, you must complete payment of your \$100 non-refundable deposit. Registration will be done through the 2024 SCN Ice Show Google registration form and the deposit will be paid through Square. You will find the link to the Square payment at the end of the 2024 SCN Ice Show Google registration form. You can also find a QR Code on the last page of this packet.
 - Late or incomplete registrations **will not** be accepted.
 - Registrations without payment of the non-refundable deposit will not be accepted.
- Registration deadline is November 14th, 2024. Late registration will <u>NOT</u> be accepted.
- All registrations will be done online.

 - FULL SHOW Dress Rehearsal Thursday, May 9th, 2024
 - o FRIDAY SHOW May 10th, 2024 7:00 pm
 - SATURDAY SHOWS May 11th, 2024 1:00 pm and 7:00 pm
- Costume Distribution and Picture Day dates are tentative and subject to change.
- ATTENDANCE POLICY
 - Due to our limited number of practices, attendance is **mandatory**! A skater may be dismissed from a number due to unexcused absences. This decision is left up to the discretion of the Choreographer and the Ice Show Director.

• Any absence **due to emergency circumstances** should be communicated to both the Choreographer of the number(s) and the Ice Show Director.

PARENT VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENT

- A parent or an adult family member MUST VOLUNTEER for one job during the final rehearsal week or weekend of the shows.
- A Sign-Up Genius will be emailed out mid-January 2024 for volunteers to make their initial job selection.
- All volunteer hours completed for the show will count toward volunteer hours required for the Skating Club of Novi membership.

GROUP ASSIGNMENTS

- All registered skaters will be assigned a group number.
- <u>SCN MEMBERS</u>
 - Group assignments will be made based on registration numbers and at the discretion of the Ice Show Director.
- LEARN-TO-SKATE PARTICIPANTS
 - **ALL ages and levels** of Learn to Skate participants are welcome and **encouraged** to participate! This includes Snowplow Sam 1 through Free Skate 6 and Adults!
 - Learn to Skate participants MUST be enrolled in Learn to Skate at the Novi Ice Arena **OR** have a current Learn to Skate Membership associated with the Suburban Skating School.
 - Learn to Skate participants will be placed in group numbers according to their level at the time of registration.
 - Please note: Groups may have multiple levels due to registration numbers. Age may not be a determining factor for placement of Learn to Skate participants due to registration numbers.
- ASPIRE PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS
 - ASPIRE Program participants MUST have a 2023-24 Aspire Membership with the SCN.
 - Group assignments will be made based on registration numbers and at the discretion of the Ice Show Director.
- Registration Fee:
 - SCN Members: \$220
 - Learn to Skate Participants: \$185
 - ASPIRE Participants: \$185
 - **NEW**: Each registrant will receive a complimentary link to the performance video.

SHOW OPENING NUMBER

- Registration Cost: \$85
- Act 1 Opening
- To participate, skaters must have passed Pre-Bonze Skating Skills.

SHOW CLOSING NUMBER

- Registration Cost: \$85
- Act 2 Closing
- To participate in this number, skaters must have passed Pre-Bronze Skating Skills.

SCN HIGH SCHOOL PRODUCTION

- Registration Cost: \$20
- All skaters who are attending high school are invited to participate in the High School Production number in addition to their group number.
- The High School Production is open to skaters of all levels.
- Skaters may be expected to attend off-ice practices prior to on-ice practices on dates and times TBD.
- Skaters will wear their high school's competition uniform and their varsity jacket (if applicable).
- If you are a graduating senior, please indicate so on your registration form. *

SCN ALUMNI PRODUCTION

- Registration Cost: \$20
- All SCN alumni are invited to participate in a group number in the ice show.
- Music will be chosen and provided by the Ice Show Director.
- This group is a stand-alone group and does not include any other participation in the show.
- Skaters must be a member in good standing with USFSA to be eligible to participate.
- The Alumni Production is open to SCN alumni skaters of all levels.
- Practices will be coordinated by the Ice Show Director.
- The group will have limited rehearsal time, so attendance is mandatory.
- Costumes will be selected by the Ice Show Directors. Cost of costumes will be the responsibility of the alumni skaters.

SOLO, DUET, TRIO, and QUARTET

On the registration page, check the corresponding box if interested in being considered for one of the following based on eligibility and registration. Skaters are <u>not</u> guaranteed a spot as a solo, primary solo, duet, trio, or quartet regardless of eligibility if they list themselves as interested during registration. Additionally, skaters will not be selected for one of these roles if they do not indicate interest during registration. Skaters must be enrolled in private lessons. Skaters must meet all the criteria listed to be considered. Each skater's singles and skating skill level will be verified by his/her coach and USFS. *NOTE: If a skater is registered to test at a March test session, the Ice Show Director will honor that level being tested when determining assignments.*

*PLEASE CONSULT ELIGIBILITY WITH YOUR COACH. There are a finite number of spots for solos. Please register for both a primary solo and a secondary solo if you are interested in a solo of any kind. There are no guarantees for solo spots regardless of eligibility.

- PRIMARY SOLO
 - Registration Cost: \$50
 - o Passed Pre-Bronze Singles Test AND/OR Pre-Silver Skating Skills Test
 - Consistently land an axel within a program*
 - If you would like to be considered for a Primary Solo, you must email a video that includes your axel, best spin, and your musicality and expression to <u>scofnovi.iceshow@gmail.com</u>
 - *****Exceptions can be made if other criteria are met.

- SECONDARY SOLO
 - Registration Cost: \$30
 - o Passed Pre-Preliminary Singles Test AND/OR Pre-Bronze Skating Skills Test
 - If you would like to be considered for a Secondary Solo, you must email a video that includes your best jump and spin, and your musicality and expression to <u>scofnovi.iceshow@gmail.com</u>

• DUET/TRIO/QUARTET

- Registration Cost: \$30
- o Passed Preliminary Skating Skills Test
- Must be able to land a loop jump
- Skaters awarded a solo are eligible for an additional duet, trio, or quartet but MUST indicate that they are interested on their registration form.
- Skaters interested in being placed in a duet, trio, or quartet are asked to name who they would like to skate with on their registration form. All skaters must meet the requirements for such a number. Skaters may request to keep their assigned duet, trios, or quartets from last year. We encourage skaters to work with students who take from the same coach, although that is not a requirement.
- If you would like to be considered for a Duet, Trio, or Quartet, you must email a video that includes your loop jump, best spin, and your musicality and expression to <u>scofnovi.iceshow@gmail.com</u>
- Music will be chosen and provided by the Ice Show Director for all solos, duets, trios, and quartets.
- Soloist performers may choose their own costume; however, it is subject to approval by the Ice Show Director. Soloists are responsible for the cost of their costume. All costumes must be approved by the Ice Show Director by March 1st, 2024.
- Practice and choreography will be arranged with the skater's coach on freestyle ice.
- Soloists, duets, trios, and quartets are responsible for all coaching and practice ice fees incurred.

Please note that eligibility requirements may change from year to year to fit the needs of our club.
